A BILL FOR

An Act to appropriate from the general fund of the state of Iowa for capital improvements to the liquor control commission.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund
2 of the state to the liquor control commission the sum of forty-
3 four thousand dollars (\$44,000.00), to be used in the following
4 manner:

- 5 For replacement and purchase of new forklift trucks;
- 6 For replacement and purchase of new tuggers; and
- 7 For new pallet dollies and a rail dock board.

1 Sec. 2. Before any of the funds herein appropriated shall be
2 expended, it shall be determined by the liquor control commission,
3 with the approval of the executive council, that its expenditures
4 are in the best interests of the state.

1 Sec. 3. Any unencumbered balance remaining as of June 30,
2 1967, of the appropriation of this Act made by the sixty-first
3 general assembly, shall revert to the general fund of the state
4 as of June 30, 1967.
