A BILL FOR

An Act to appropriate from the general fund of the state of Iowa for the biennium beginning July 1, 1965, and ending June 30, 1967, to the state fair board for the purpose of state aid to agricultural societies.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. For the state fair board for the purpose of state
- 2 aid to agricultural societies there is appropriated from the
- 3 general fund of the state for each year of the biennium beginning
- 4 July 1, 1965, and ending June 30, 1967, the sum of two hundred
- 5 ten thousand dollars (\$210,000.00), or so much thereof as may be
- 6 necessary to be used in the following manner:
- 7 For state aid to agricultural societies.....\$210,000.00
- 8 The foregoing appropriation for state aid to agricultural
- 9 societies shall be deemed conditional on full compliance with all
- 10 other statutes which regulate and prescribe the conditions under
- 11 which such aid is payable. In no case shall any county receive
- 12 more than two thousand one hundred dollars (\$2,100.00) except
- 13 that in a county where there are two definitely separate county
- 14 extension offices, each such society shall receive state aid in
- 15 such amount as it would be entitled to if it were the only society
- 16 in the county. In counties having more than one fair entitled to
- 17 state aid, the state aid available for the county shall be
- 18 prorated to said fairs on the basis of cash premiums paid by said
- 19 fairs.
