A BILL FOR

An Act authorizing capital expenditures by the state highway commission from the primary road fund for the biennium beginning July 1, 1965, and ending June 30, 1967.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. The state highway commission is hereby authorized
 2 to expend from the primary road fund the sum of two million
 3 sixty-eight thousand dollars (\$2,068,000.00), or so much thereof
 4 as may be necessary to be used in the following manner, to wit:

5 (1) For construction, replacement or repairs of maintenance
 6 buildings\$2,000,000.00

7 (2) For the purchase of a twin-engine aircraft.
 8 The authority to assign utilization of the aircraft
 9 shall be vested in the highway commissioners, with
 10 the assessing of maintenance and operational costs,
 11 including depreciation and motor overhaul costs, to
 12 individual departments on the basis of such utiliza-
 13 tion vested in the highway commissioners.....\$ 68,000.00

1 Sec. 2. The highway commission is hereby authorized to obtain
2 and accept federal grants and/or funds to the state to be used
3 in connection with the funds authorized in this Act, and federal
4 funds in addition thereto.

1 Sec. 3. Any unencumbered balance remaining as of June 30, 1969,
2 of the state authorization for funds in this Act shall revert
3 to the primary road fund as of June 30, 1969.

1 Sec. 4. Before any funds herein authorized by this Act

2 relating to the purchase of the aircraft shall be expended, it

3 shall be determined by the highway commission, with the approval

4 of the governor, the state comptroller, and the adjutant general,

5 that the expenditure shall be in the best interests of the state.

1 Sec. 5. If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence,

2 clause or phrase of this Act is for any reason held to be

3 unconstitutional or invalid, such unconstitutionality or invalidity

4 shall not affect the constitutionality or validity of the remain-

5 ing portions of this Act. The general assembly hereby declares

6 that it would have passed this Act and each section, subsection,

7 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase hereof irrespective of

8 whether any one or more of the sections, subsections, paragraphs,

9 sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitutional.

1 Sec. 6. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance, shall

2 be in full force and effect from and after its passage and pub-

3 lication in the Fort Dodge Messenger, a newspaper published in

4 Fort Dodge, Iowa, and in the Algona-Kossuth Advance, a newspaper

5 published in Algona, Iowa.
