A BILL FOR

An Act relating to the filing of assessment protests with the board of review.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Section four hundred forty-one point thirty-three
2 (441.33), Code 1962, is hereby amended as follows:

3 1. By inserting in line three (3) after the word "year" the
4 following:

5 "and for such additional period as may be required under section
6 four hundred forty-one point thirty-seven (441.37) of the Code".

7 2. By inserting in line five (5) after the number "1" the
8 following:

9 "in any year in which a session has not been extended as re-
10 quired under section four hundred forty-one point thirty-seven
11 (441.37) of the Code,".

12 3. By inserting in line nine (9) after the number "1" the
13 following:

14 "in those years in which the session has not been extended under
15 section four hundred forty-one point thirty-seven (441.37) of the
16 Code".

17 4. By inserting in line fifteen (15) after the word "session"
18 the words "required under section four hundred forty-one point
19 thirty-seven (441.37) of the Code or".

1 Sec. 2. Section four hundred forty-one point thirty-seven

2 (441.37), Code 1962, is hereby amended by inserting in line six
3 (6) after the word "assessment." the following:

4 "In any county which has been declared to be a disaster area
5 by proper federal authorities after March 1 and prior to May 20
6 of said year of assessment, the time for filing a protest shall
7 be extended to June 20 of such year."

1 Sec. 3. Section four hundred forty-one point forty-five
2 (441.45), Code 1962, is hereby amended by striking line twenty-
3 five (25) and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

4 "under provisions of sections four hundred forty-one point
5 thirty-three (441.33) and four hundred forty-one point thirty-
6 seven (441.37) of the Code the abstract".

1 Sec. 4. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance, shall
2 take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the
3 Burlington Hawk-Eye, a newspaper published in Burlington, Iowa,
4 and in The Muscatine Journal, a newspaper published in Muscatine,
5 Iowa.
