# A BILL FOR

An Act to make appropriations to legislators serving on legislative advisory committees.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated out of the general  
2 fund of the state of Iowa to the following named persons the  
3 amounts set opposite their respective names in full settlement of  
4 all claims which they may have against the state of Iowa on account  
5 of services rendered as a member of, or while serving in the  
6 capacity of alternate member of, a legislative advisory committee  
7 established by the legislative research committee by the authority  
8 of sections two point fifty-five (2.55) and two point fifty-six  
9 (2.56), Code 1962.

1     Sec. 2. The state comptroller is hereby authorized to issue  
2 his warrants to the above-named parties in the amounts stated,  
3 and the treasurer is hereby directed to pay the same from the  
4 designated funds or accounts of the state of Iowa.

1     Sec. 3. The acceptance of said sums by the above-named par-  
2 ties shall be in full settlement of all claims against the state  
3 of Iowa growing out of the above-described claims.

1     Sec. 4. This Act being deemed of immediate importance shall  
2 take effect and be in full force from and after its publication  
3 in The Albia Union-Republican, a newspaper published at Albia,  
4 Iowa, and Chariton Herald-Patriot, a newspaper published at Chariton,  
5 Iowa.
