A BILL FOR

An Act relating to retirement age for firemen and policemen in cities where firemen and policemen are appointed under civil service.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. Section four hundred eleven point six (411.6),
- 2 Code 1962, is amended by striking from subsection one (1),
- 3 paragraph b., line two (2), the word "seventy" and inserting
- 4 in lieu thereof the word "sixty-five (65)".

- 11 ber to remain in service for periods not to exceed one year
