## A BILL FOR

An Act relating to speed limits on freeways.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

- 1 Section 1. Section three hundred twenty-one point two
- 2 hundred eighty-five (321.285), Code 1962, is hereby amended
- 3 by inserting in line eleven (11) of subsection eight (8)
- 4 immediately following the word "sunrise" the words "except
- 5 that upon such highways located within the corporate limits
- 6 of any city or town the speed limit shall be fifty (50) miles
- 7 per hour".

- 2 section 1, immediately following the word "town",
- 3 the words, ", used as city alternate routes, commonly
