A BILL FOR

An Act relating to drag racing on Iowa's streets and highways.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. Chapter three hundred twenty-one (321), Code 1962,
- 2 is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:
- 3 "No person shall engage in any motor vehicle speed contest or
- 4 exhibition of speed on any street or highway of this state and
- 5 no person shall aid or abet any motor vehicle speed contest or
- 6 speed exhibition on any street or highway of this state.
- 7 "Any person who violates the provisions of this section shall
- 8 be guilty of drag racing and upon conviction shall be punished
- 9 by a fine of not more than one hundred (100) dollars or by im-
- 10 prisonment in the county jail for not more than thirty (30) days."
