An Act relating to powers of cities and towns regarding the use of joint facilities.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. Section three hundred sixty-eight point twelve
- 2 (368.12), Code 1962, is hereby amended by inserting in line six
- 3 (6) after the word "township" the words "or benefited fire
- 4 district as provided in chapter three hundred fifty-seven A
- 5 (357A) of the Code".

(Committee Amendment)

- 1 1. Amend the title by inserting in line 1 after the word
- 2 "towns" the words "and benefited fire districts".
- 3 2. Amend by adding the following section:
- 4 Sec. 2. Chapter three hundred fifty-seven A (357A), Code 1962,
- 5 is hereby amended by adding the following section:
- 6 "No benefited fire district shall join with any city or town
- 7 for any joint purpose permitted in section three hundred sixty-
- 8 eight point twelve (368.12) of the Code unless such joining is
- 9 approved by the electors of the joint benefited fire district as
- 10 provided in this section. The trustees of a benefited fire dis-
- 11 trict shall have the power, when authorized by a majority vote of
- 12 the electors thereof at a special election called for that purpose,
- 13 upon notice given in the same manner provided in section three
- 14 hundred fifty-seven A point nine (357A.9) of the Code, to own, use,
- 15 or operate jointly with any city or town, fire apparatus, equip-
- 16 ment, or facilities and to provide for the purchase, rental, or
- 17 maintenance of such equipment, facilities, and services." *adopted 2/3*
