A BILL FOR

An Act to amend chapter two hundred eighty-two (282), Code 1962,
to provide for the education of children in state controlled
institutions.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. Chapter two hundred eighty-two (282), Code 1962,
- 2 is hereby amended by adding the following section:
- 3 "When any child is cared for in any state supported institution
- 4 in this state which does not maintain a school and the domicile
- 5 of the child is in another school district than that wherein the
- 6 institution is situated, then such child shall be entitled to
- 7 attend school in the district where such institution is located,
- 8 provided, however, the board of the district has the authority to
- 9 determine if such child can be benefited from such attendance.
- 10 In such case the cost of tuition and transportation, at the rates
- 11 established by law, shall be paid by the treasurer of the state
- 12 from any funds in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated
- 13 and from warrants drawn by the state comptroller upon requisition
- 14 of the superintendent of public instruction."
