A BILL FOR

Industrial + human relations 3/23 substituted for HF 175 - 3/22

An Act relating to state boiler inspector.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Section eighty-nine point two (89.2), Code 1962,
2 as amended by chapters ninety-two (92) and ninety-three (93),
3 Acts 60th General Assembly is further amended by adding new sub-
4 sections as follows:

5 "7. All steam boilers used for heating purposes carrying a
6 pressure of not more than fifteen (15) pounds per square inch
7 gauge and located in places of public assembly.

8 "8. All hot water heating boilers carrying a pressure of not
9 more than thirty (30) pounds per square inch gauge located in
10 places of public assembly."

1 Sec. 2. Section eighty-nine point three (89.3), Code 1962,
2 is amended by inserting in line ten (10) after the word "build-
3 ings," the following:

4 "except buildings of public assembly as defined in section
5 eighty-nine point twelve (89.12) of the Code as amended."

1 Sec. 3. Section eighty-nine point twelve (89.12), Code 1962,
2 is amended by adding the following new subsections:

3 "3. Low-pressure heating boiler. The term 'low pressure
4 heating boiler' shall mean a steam boiler operated at pressures
5 not exceeding fifteen (15) psig, or a hot water heating boiler

6 not exceeding thirty (30) pounds per square inch gauge.
7 "4. Place of public assembly. 'Place of public assembly'
8 shall mean any building or portion thereof designed, intended
9 and used for occupation by persons for purposes of entertainment,
10 instruction or amusement and shall be construed to include
11 theatres, motion picture theaters, hospitals, places of worship,
12 schools, colleges and institutions."

1 Sec. 4. Section eighty-nine point six (89.6), Code 1962, is
2 amended as follows:

3 1. Strike from line thirteen (13) of subsection one (1) the
4 word "one dollar" and insert in lieu thereof the word "two (2)
5 dollars".

6 2. By adding at the end of subsection one (1) the following
7 paragraph;

8 "Upon such showing and the payment of a fee of two dollars
9 (\$2.00) for each one (1) year inspection and four dollars (\$4.00)
10 for each two (2) year inspection, the commissioner of labor shall
11 issue a certificate of inspection by the bureau of labor, which shall
12 be valid only for the period specified in section eighty-nine
13 point two (89.2) of the Code."

1 Sec. 5. Section eighty-nine point seven (89.7), Code 1962,
2 as amended, is amended as follows:

3 1. By striking subsection one (1) and inserting the following:

4 "1. Boilers having a working pressure to seventy (70) pounds
5 per square inch ten dollars (\$10.00) for one (1) boiler and
6 eight dollars (\$8.00) for each additional boiler of like size
7 when set in batteries."

8 2. By striking from line three (3) of subsection two (2) the
9 word "six" and insert in lieu thereof the word "twelve (12)";

10 also strike from line four (4) of said subsection the word "four"
11 and insert in lieu thereof the word "ten (10)".

12 3. By striking from line three (3) of subsection three (3)
13 the word "seven" and insert in lieu thereof the word "fourteen
14 (14)"; also strike from line four (4) of said subsection the
15 word "five" and insert in lieu thereof the word "twelve (12)".

16 4. By striking from line three (3) of subsection four (4)
17 the word "nine" and insert in lieu thereof the word "eighteen
18 (18)"; also strike from line four (4) of said subsection the
19 word "six" and insert in lieu thereof the word "twelve (12)".

20 5. By striking from line seven (7) of subsection five (5)
21 the word "five" and insert in lieu thereof the word "ten (10)";
22 also strike from line nine (9) of said subsection the word "six"
23 and insert in lieu thereof the word "twelve (12)"; also strike
24 from line eleven (11) of said subsection the word "seven" and
25 insert in lieu thereof the word "fourteen (14)".

1 Sec. 6. Section eighty-nine point eight (89.8), Code 1962, is
2 hereby repealed and the following enacted in lieu thereof:

3 "All fees provided for in this chapter shall be collected by
4 the commissioner of labor and remitted to the state treasurer,
5 together with an itemized statement showing the source of collection,
6 and such fees shall be credited to the bureau of labor for purposes
7 of administration of this law."
