SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION

A Joint Resolution proposing an amendment to the constitution of the State of Iowa relating to the effective date of laws of the General Assembly passed at a general session.

Be It Resolved by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. The following amendment to the constitution of the
2 State of Iowa is hereby proposed:

3 Section twenty-six (26) of Article III is amended by striking
4 from line four (4) the word "fourth" and inserting in lieu thereof
5 the word "first".

1 Sec. 2. The foregoing proposed amendment, having been adopted
2 and agreed to by the Sixtieth (60th) General Assembly, thereafter
3 duly published, and now adopted and agreed to by the Sixty-First
4 (61st) General Assembly in this Joint Resolution, shall be sub-
5 mitted to the people of the State of Iowa at the general election
6 in November of the year nineteen hundred sixty-six (1966) in the
7 manner required by the Constitution of the State of Iowa and the
8 laws of the State of Iowa.
