# SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION

A Joint Resolution proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the State of Iowa to give the Governor the authority to appoint a Secretary of State, Treasurer of State, and Attorney General and to provide that the General Assembly shall appoint an Auditor of State.

*Be It Resolved by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

- 1 Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of the
- 2 State of Iowa is hereby proposed:

Section twenty-two (22) of Article four (IV) and section twelve  
 4 (12) of Article five (V) of the Constitution of the State of Iowa  
 5 are hereby repealed and the following adopted in lieu thereof:

6 "The Governor shall have the power to appoint a Secretary of  
 7 State, Treasurer of State, and Attorney General who shall serve at  
 8 the pleasure of the Governor and shall perform such duties as may  
 9 be prescribed by law. Appointments shall be made with the consent  
 10 of two-thirds (2/3) of the Senate."

11 Article three (III) of the Constitution of the State of Iowa  
 12 is hereby amended by adding thereto the following new section:

13 "An Auditor of State shall be appointed by and shall serve at  
 14 the pleasure of the General Assembly. The Auditor shall conduct  
 15 post audits and perform such other duties as may be prescribed by  
 16 law and shall report to the General Assembly and the Governor."

- 1 Sec. 2. The foregoing proposed amendment to the Constitution
- 2 of the State of Iowa is hereby referred to the general assembly

3 to be chosen at the next general election for members of the  
 4 general assembly and the secretary of state is directed to cause  
 5 the same to be published for three (3) consecutive months previous  
 6 to the date of said election as provided by law.

 2 from line 3 all after the words "Secretary of State" and in-  
 3 serting in lieu thereof the words "and Treasurer of State".  
 4 Further amend Senate Joint Resolution 11, section 1, by  
 5 striking lines 3 through 7 inclusive, and inserting in lieu  
 6 thereof "Section twenty-two (22) of Article four (IV) of the  
 7 Constitution of the State of Iowa is hereby repealed and the  
 8 following adopted in lieu thereof:  
 9 "The Governor shall have the power to appoint a Secretary  
 10 of State and Treasurer of State, who shall serve at".
