A BILL FOR

An Act relating to support and maintenance of the parties during divorce litigation.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Section five hundred ninety-eight point
2 eleven (598.11), Code 1966, is hereby amended by adding
3 thereto the following:

4 "The court may make such an order, upon application of
5 either party, after service of the original notice; provided,
6 however, no such order shall be entered until at least three
7 (3) days notice of hearing, and opportunity to be heard, is
8 given the adverse party."

EXPLANATION

This bill permits the court to award temporary support and maintenance and attorney fees after a three (3) day period of notice instead of the present twenty (20) day period of notice.

1 Amend House File 17 as follows:
2 1. Amend section one (1) by striking the word "three" in line
3 six (6) and the figure "3" in line seven (7) thereof and substituting
4 the word and figure "five" (5)" therefor.
5 2. Further amend by adding the following new section:
6 "Appearance by an attorney or the defendant for such hearing shall
7 be deemed a special appearance for the purpose of such hearing only
8 and not a general appearance."
