A BILL FOR

An Act relating to the requirement of United States citizenship in determining eligibility for aid for the blind.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. Section two hundred forty-one point two
- 2 (241.2), Code 1966, is hereby amended by striking all of
- 3 subsection two (2) of such section.

EXPLANATION

This bill repeals the present requirement that applicants for aid to the blind be United States citizens or have applied for citizenship. Very few applicants are affected by this provision, and it is very time consuming to investigate all cases on this one point of eligibility.
