## A BILL FOR

An Act relating to benefits to be given to retired persons under the Iowa old-age and survivors' insurance system who have reached the age of seventy-two years.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 Section 1. Section ninety-seven point fifty-one (97.51),  
2 Code 1966, is hereby amended by adding at the end of subsection  
3 six (6) after the word "months" the words ", except that after  
4 a retired member reaches the age of seventy-two (72) years,  
5 the member, his wife and dependents shall be entitled to the  
6 benefits of this chapter regardless of the amount earned".

### EXPLANATION

This bill provides the same provision as to unlimited earnings to persons retired under the Iowa O.A.S.I. that the Sixty-first General Assembly accorded to retired persons under I.P.E.R.S. who have reached the age of seventy-two years.
