# A BILL FOR

An Act relating to investigations involving probation by the court.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. Section two hundred forty-seven point twenty
- 2 (247.20), Code 1966, is hereby amended by inserting in
- 3 line fourteen (14) after the word "investigation" the words
- 4 ", by the board of parole,".

## EXPLANATION

Since the board of parole is now making most of the presentence investigations for the courts or judges, this bill will clarify the law in connection with these duties.

- 1 Amend House File 246, line four (4) by adding after the word
- 2 "parole" the words "or probation officer,".
