## A BILL FOR

### EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 257

Because of the many interpretations given the word "violated" in Section 247.12 of the Code, a number of prisoners have brought lawsuits against the State claiming the time they were on parole should be counted on their sentence. By changing the word "violated" to the word "revoked" as this bill suggests, the section will be clarified.
