A BILL FOR

An Act to repeal chapter seven hundred thirty (730), Code 1966, relating to desecration of Decoration Day.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. Chapter seven hundred thirty (730), Code
- 2 1966, is hereby repealed.

EXPLANATION

This chapter of the Iowa Code provides for a penalty for sports and entertainment performed prior to 3:00 P.M. on Decoration Day. Repeal of this chapter will not change the proper observance and respect due this legal holiday. The Desecration of Sabbath, Chapter 729, was repealed by the 56th General Assembly.
