A BILL FOR

An Act relating to interference with devices, signs, signals, or barricades.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Section three hundred twenty-one point two
 2 hundred sixty (321.260), Code 1966, is hereby repealed and
 3 the following is enacted in lieu thereof:
 4 "Any person who willfully and intentionally, without lawful
 5 authority, attempts to or in fact alters, defaces, injures,
 6 knocks down, or removes any official traffic-control device,
 7 any authorized warning sign or signal or barricade, whether
 8 temporary or permanent, any railroad sign or signal, any
 9 inscription, shield or insignia on any of such devices, signs,
 10 signals, or barricades, or any other part thereof, shall,
 11 upon conviction, be punished by imprisonment in the county
 12 jail for not more than six (6) months, or fined not more
 13 than five hundred (500) dollars, or by both such fine and
 14 imprisonment."

EXPLANATION

This bill amends Section 321.260 of the Code and would prevent the unlawful damaging or removal of barricades, warning signs and signals from public roads and would make such violation an indictable offense.

1 Amend the title to House File 287 by striking all after
2 the word "with" in line one (1) and by inserting in lieu thereof
3 the following: "official traffic-control devices, signs, signals,
4 or barricades or with railroad signs or signals."
