A BILL FOR

An Act relating to the sale of skins and plumage of lawfully taken game birds and animals.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

This is a Companion Bill; for complete text see Senate File 354.

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 309

At the present time, it is illegal to sell the plumage and skins of lawfully taken game birds and animals. Each year the hides of several thousand deer are either thrown away or disposed of illegally. The plumage of game birds and the tails of squirrels are presently wasted. The value of the skins or plumage so sold would not be sufficient inducement to encourage violation of existing game laws, but would be a source of revenue for those who might be interested.

This bill legalizes the sale of skins and plumage of lawfully taken game birds and animals.

1 Amend House File 309 as follows:

2 1. Amend the title, line 1, by striking the words "and
3 plumage".

4 2. Amend the title, line 2, by striking the words "birds
5 and".

6 3. Amend Section 1, line 4, by striking the words "or
7 plumage".

8 4. Amend Section 1, line 5, by striking all after the word
9 "taken" and insert in lieu thereof the following "deer. Such
10 deer hides shall be plainly labelled with the owner's name
11 and address and license number prior to the sale. This
12 name and address and license number must remain attached
13 to the hide while such hide is within the boundaries of this
14 state."
