## A BILL FOR

An Act prohibiting the placing of red reflectors on the right of way of a public highway.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 Section 1. Section three hundred nineteen point twelve  
2 (319.12), Code 1966, is hereby amended by adding thereto the  
3 following:  
4 "Except for official traffic control devices as defined by  
5 section three hundred twenty-one point one (321.1), subsection  
6 sixty-two (62), of the Code, no person shall place, erect, or  
7 attach any red reflector, or any object or other device which  
8 shall cause a red reflectorized effect, within the boundary  
9 lines of the public highways so as to be visible to passing  
10 motorists."

### EXPLANATION

This bill prohibits red reflectors within the boundary lines of highways. Such reflectors are confusing and distracting to motorists and should be removed as a safety measure.
