A BILL FOR

An Act to provide for the canvassing of votes and the inauguration of the governor and lieutenant governor at any suitable hall at the seat of government.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Section two point thirty-one (2.31), Code 1966,
2 is amended by adding at the end thereof a new paragraph as
3 follows:

4 "The speaker of the house of representatives may, for pur-
5 poses of canvas of votes for governor and lieutenant governor
6 and for the inauguration of such officers, designate any suit-
7 able hall at the seat of government as the hall of the house
8 of representatives."

EXPLANATION

This bill allows the inauguration of the governor to be held anywhere in Des Moines at the discretion of the speaker of the house.
