## A BILL FOR

An Act relating to the size limit on certain fish taken with commercial fishing gear.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

- 1 Section 1. Section one hundred nine point one hundred
- 2 thirteen (109.113), Code 1966, is hereby amended by striking
- 3 all of such section after the word "long" in line four (4)
- 4 and inserting in lieu thereof a period.

### EXPLANATION

There is no biological reason for a size limit on certain fish. The size of some fish taken is controlled by the market. The markets will not buy these small fish; therefore, the fishermen will not take them. This bill eliminates reference in the Code to size limit on the sheepshead, sucker, redhorse, buffalo, and bullhead.
