## A BILL FOR

An Act relating to rules and regulations set forth by the department of public instruction.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 Section 1. Section two hundred fifty-seven point  
2 twenty-five (257.25), Code 1966, is amended as follows:  
3 1. By striking from subsection eight (8), paragraph a,  
4 all of subparagraph one (1) and inserting in lieu thereof  
5 the following:

6 "The board shall specify the classification of schools  
7 that shall employ a full time librarian and the classifications  
8 that may employ a part time librarian. The board shall  
9 classify the various schools by the number of students in  
10 attendance, the nature of the academic curriculum, and other  
11 standards that are appropriate. The board shall also take  
12 into account the number of qualified librarians available."

13 2. By striking from subsection eight (8), paragraph b, the  
14 first two (2) sentences and inserting in lieu thereof the  
15 following:

16 "The board shall specify the classification of high schools  
17 that shall employ a full time guidance counselor and the  
18 classifications that may employ a part time guidance counselor.  
19 The board shall classify the various high schools by the  
20 number of students in attendance and any other standards that

21 are appropriate. The board shall also take into account  
22 the number of professionally trained guidance counselors  
23 available."

24 3. By striking from line twenty-four (24) of subsection  
25 eleven (11) the words "In lieu of removal, the" and inserting  
26 in lieu thereof the word "The".

27 4. By striking from line twenty-five (25) of subsection  
28 eleven (11) the word "may" and inserting in lieu thereof  
29 the word "shall".

30 5. By inserting in line twenty-six (26) of subsection  
31 eleven (11) after the word "time" the words ", which shall  
32 be at least one (1) year,".

33 6. By adding to subsection eleven (11) the following  
34 sentence:

35 "The reasonable period of time for compliance shall be  
36 given prior to the one (1) year notice requirement that is  
37 required under subsection twelve (12) of this section."

#### EXPLANATION

This bill makes desirable changes in the minimum school standards, applying to private as well as public schools, which were adopted by the 1965 General Assembly. Provisions of the bill relate to the requirements of full time and part time librarians and full time guidance counselors.

The bill also provides for a reasonable period of time being granted by the state board for compliance with approval standards, rules, and regulations if the failure to comply is due to factors beyond the control of the board of directors or governing body of the school, college, or school district.

1 Amend House File 465, Section 1, as follows:  
2 By inserting in lines six (6), eight (8), eleven (11),  
3 sixteen (16), nineteen (19) and twenty-one (21), preceding  
4 the word "board" the word "state".

34 7. By striking from subsection eight (8) paragraph  
35 "b", the first three (3) lines inclusive and the words

40 the classifications that may employ, or share with other  
41 public or private schools, a part time guidance counselor.  
42 The board shall classify the various high schools by the

46 8. By inserting in line two (2) of paragraph "c" of  
47 subsection eight (8) after the word "public" the words "and  
48 private".  
49 9. By inserting in line twenty eight (28) of subsection  
50 ten (10) after the word "standards" the following:  
51 ", the type of school involved, and the needs of the  
52 community".  
53 10. By striking lines twenty-nine (29), thirty (30),  
54 and thirty-one (31) of subsection ten (10).  
55 11. By striking from line twenty four (24) of  
56 subsection eleven (11) the words "In lieu of removal, the"  
57 and inserting in lieu thereof the word "The".  
58 12. By striking from line twenty five (25) of  
59 subsection eleven (11) the word "may" and inserting in lieu  
60 thereof the word "shall".  
61 13. By inserting in line twenty six (26) of sub-  
62 section eleven (11) after the word "time" the words ", which  
63 shall be at least one (1) year,".  
64 14. By adding to subsection eleven the following  
65 sentence: "The reasonable period of time for compliance  
66 shall be given prior to the one (1) year notice require-  
67 ment under subsection twelve (12) of this section."  
68 Section 2. Section two hundred fifty-seven point  
69 twenty six (257.26), Code 1966 is hereby amended by  
70 striking from lines seven (7), eight (8), and nine (9)  
71 or subsection (2) the following:  
72 "if any, in schools maintaining standards equivalent  
73 to the approval standards for public schools,".
