**A BILL FOR**

An Act relating to the millage levy for improvements and maintenance of county hospitals in counties having a population of two hundred twenty-five thousand (225,000) inhabitants or over.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

This is a Companion Bill; for complete text see Senate File 542.

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 495

This bill actually applies only to the tax levy for Broadlawns Polk County Hospital. It has been necessary for Broadlawns to levy an additional mill as an emergency levy for a period of three years making the tax levy a total of five mills. This increase proposed in the bill for improvements and maintenance of the hospital from four to five mills is permissive and is no more than has been levied on an emergency basis. With the advent of the minimum wage law and increased wages generally, no immediate possibility of a reduction in hospital costs is possible. Medicare and Medicaid may eventually allow a tax reduction for support of Broadlawns.
