## A BILL FOR

An Act relating to the sale and transfer of mobile homes.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

- 1 Section 1. Section three hundred twenty-one point
- 2 forty-five (321.45), Code 1966, is hereby amended by
- 3 adding thereto the following new subsection:
- 4 "Within five (5) days of the sale of a mobile home, the
- 5 dealer making the sale shall certify to the county treasurer
- 6 of the county where the unit is to be located, the name and
- 7 address of the purchaser, and the make, taxable size, and
- 8 identification number of the unit."

### EXPLANATION

There is reason to believe some vehicles in the mobile home class escape taxation. All are not parked in a mobile home court. Some purchasers get the erroneous notion that the manufacturer's certificate issued them is their certificate of title required by Iowa law. Information obtained in pursuance of above provision can be referred to enforcement division of state motor vehicle department if collection cannot otherwise be achieved. This proposal should help correct the problem.
