## A BILL FOR

An Act to make an appropriation to the secretary of agriculture to print the animal brand book required by law.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the general  
2 fund of the state to the secretary of agriculture the sum of  
3 twenty-five hundred (2500) dollars to be used for publishing  
4 the brand book for animals required by section one hundred  
5 eighty-seven point eleven (187.11) of the Code.

### EXPLANATION

This bill would provide funds for the publication of the brands book that is required to be published by law. There are no other funds which can be used for this publication.

From July 1, 1965 to March 1, 1967, 2138 livestock brands have been recorded. The recording fee for each brand being \$15.00, a total of \$32,070.00 has been diverted to the general fund with no budget provisions to publish a brand book.

The law as enacted by the last General Assembly requires that a book be provided without charge to each county recorder in the State of Iowa within a reasonable length of time. All others are to be sold by the department for the cost of printing and postage.
