## A BILL FOR

An Act relating to the membership of the higher education facilities commission.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 Section 1. Section two hundred sixty-one point one (261.1),  
2 Code 1966, is hereby amended as follows:

3 1. By inserting in line three (3) of subsection four (4)  
4 after the word "years." the following:

5 "Any appointment prior to June 30, 1967 shall terminate on  
6 that date and any member appointed for a term thereafter,  
7 except to fill a vacancy, shall serve for four (4) years."

8 2. By inserting in line three (3) of subsection five (5)  
9 after the word "years." the following:

10 "Any appointment prior to June 30, 1969 shall terminate on  
11 that date and any member appointed for a term thereafter,  
12 except to fill a vacancy, shall serve for four (4) years."

13 3. By adding thereto the following sentence:

14 "A vacancy shall exist on the commission when a legislative  
15 member of the commission ceases to be a member of the general  
16 assembly."

### EXPLANATION

This bill changes the term of the legislative members serving on the Higher Education Facilities Commission from two years to four year staggered terms. The bill also clarifies present law by making it explicit that a vacancy exists on the Commission when a legislative member ceases to be a member of the General Assembly.

1 Amend House File 569, Section 1, by adding at the end of  
sub-section  
2 three (3) the following: "Such vacancy shall be filled within  
3 thirty (30) days."
