A BILL FOR

An Act relating to species of fish which can be taken by spear or bow and arrow.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. Section one hundred nine point seventy-six
- 2 (109.76), Code 1966, is hereby amended by inserting in line
- 3 thirteen (13) after the word "gar" the word ", sheepshead".

EXPLANATION

The sheepshead is generally considered to be an undesirable species of fish with a large population in the natural lakes and streams of this State. The sheepshead frequents deep water and could be taken by fishermen using skin-diving equipment. This bill includes the sheepshead to the list of rough fish now authorized to be taken by spear or bow and arrow in this State.
