## A BILL FOR

An Act relating to littering of public waters.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

- 1 Section 1. Section one hundred six point twelve (106.12),
- 2 subsection three (3), Code 1966, is hereby amended as follows:
- 3 1. By inserting in line two (2) after the word "the" the
- 4 word "public".
- 5 2. By striking from lines three (3) and four (4) the words
- 6 "under the jurisdiction of the state conservation commission"
- 7 and inserting in lieu thereof the words "of this state".

### EXPLANATION

Present Iowa law controlling littering on state property is restricted to jurisdictions under the State Conservation Commission. Many areas owned by other governmental agencies could be opened to the public for outdoor recreation if the agencies had the authority to regulate or police the areas for littering.

This bill extends the littering prohibition to all public waters, ice, or land in the State.
