## A BILL FOR

An Act relating to the purchase and sale of motor vehicles by the state car dispatcher, and amending chapter twenty-one (21), Code 1966.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 Section 1. Section twenty-one point two (21.2), Code 1966,  
2 is hereby amended as follows:

3 1. By striking from line seven (7) of subsection four (4)  
4 the word "car" and inserting in lieu thereof the words "motor  
5 vehicle".

6 2. By striking from line ten (10) of subsection four (4)  
7 the words "or trucks" and inserting in lieu thereof the words  
8 ", trucks, or station wagons".

9 3. By inserting in line twelve (12) of subsection four (4)  
10 after the word "thousand" the words five hundred (500)".

11 4. By striking from line seventeen (17) of subsection  
12 four (4) the words "twenty-two hundred fifty" and inserting  
13 in lieu thereof the words "two thousand eight hundred  
14 (2,800)".

15 5. By adding to subsection four (4) the following sentence:  
16 "Provided further, that for station wagons the maximum amount  
17 shall be two thousand eight hundred (2,800) dollars."

18 6. By striking all of subsection five (5) and inserting in  
19 lieu thereof the following:

20 "All used motor vehicles turned in to the state car  
21 dispatcher shall be disposed of either by bid or public  
22 auction, and the receipts from such sale shall be deposited

23 in the depreciation fund to the credit of that unit within  
24 the department or agency turning in the vehicle."

1     Sec. 2. Section twenty-one point three (21.3), Code 1966,  
2 is hereby amended by striking from lines five (5) and six (6)  
3 the words "or revoke the allowance for the use of his privately  
4 owned motor vehicle,".

1     Sec. 3. Section twenty-one point six (21.6), Code 1966,  
2 is hereby amended as follows:

3     1. By striking from lines nine (9), ten (10) and eleven  
4 (11) the words "also all purchases of new motor vehicles or  
5 replacements,".

6     2. By striking from line seventeen (17) the words "and  
7 depreciation on".

1     Sec. 4. Chapter twenty-one (21), Code 1966, is amended  
2 by adding thereto the following section:

3     "The car dispatcher shall maintain a depreciation fund for  
4 the purchase of replacement motor vehicles and additions  
5 to the fleet. The dispatcher's records shall show the total  
6 funds deposited by and credited to each department or agency  
7 thereof. At the end of each month, the state car dispatcher  
8 shall render a statement to each state department or agency  
9 thereof for additions to the fleet and depreciation on each  
10 motor vehicle assigned to and owned by such department or  
11 agency. Such depreciation expense shall be paid by the state  
12 departments or agencies in the same manner as other expenses  
13 of such department are paid, and shall be deposited in the  
14 depreciation fund to the credit of the individual motor  
15 vehicle within the department or agency thereof. The funds  
16 credited to each department or agency thereof shall remain  
17 the property of the department or agency. However at the end  
18 of each biennium, the state car dispatcher shall cause to  
19 revert to the fund from which it accumulated any unassigned  
20 depreciation."

EXPLANATION

This bill requires the state car dispatcher to maintain a depreciation fund for the purchase of replacement motor vehicles and additions to the fleet, and raises the ceiling on the amount that the state can pay for certain motor vehicles.

- 2 lines twenty-one (21) and twenty-two (22) the words
- 3 "either by bid or public auction," and inserting in
- 4 lieu thereof the following: "by public auction, and
- 5 such sales shall be advertised in a newspaper of
- 6 general circulation one week in advance of sale,".

- 5 shall be disposed of by public auction, and such sales shall be
- 6 advertised twice in a newspaper of general circulation at weekly
- 7 intervals in advance of sale and the receipts from such sale shall
- 8 be deposited in the depreciation fund to the credit of that unit
- 9 within the department or agency turning in the vehicle."
