A BILL FOR

An Act relating to exemption from payment of license fees for "in transit" movement of vehicles.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Section three hundred twenty-one point nineteen
2 (321.19), Code 1966, is hereby amended by adding thereto the
3 following:
4 "For purposes of sale of vehicles exempted as herein indi-
5 cated, the exempted governmental body, upon the sale of the
6 exempted vehicle, may issue for in-transit purposes a paste-
7 board card bearing the words 'Vehicle in Transit', the name
8 of the official body from which the vehicle was purchased,
9 together with the date of the purchase plainly marked in
10 minimal of one-inch letters, and other information which may
11 be required by the department of public safety. The in-transit
12 card shall be valid for use only within forty-eight (48) hours
13 after the purchase date as indicated on the bill of sale which
14 shall be carried by the driver."

EXPLANATION

The need for the addition of the provisions of this bill to Section 321.19 of the Code is requested by many official bodies so that at the time of sale of exempted vehicles, the buyer can transport the purchased vehicle upon the public highways without obtaining a full annual registration. This bill will allow the purchasing body to legally transport his vehicle back to his county of residence where he can properly register the vehicle or to his state of residence in which he wishes to register the vehicle.
