# A BILL FOR

An Act relating to the fish and game protection fund.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Section one hundred seven point nineteen (107.19),  
2 Code 1966, is hereby amended by inserting in line five (5) after  
3 the word "game." the following:

4 "After June 30, 1967, expenditures incurred by the state con-  
5 servation commission in carrying on such activities shall be  
6 only on authorization by the general assembly.

7 "The state conservation commission shall biennially on or be-  
8 fore September 1 of each even-numbered year submit to the comp-  
9 troller for transmission to the general assembly a detailed  
10 estimate of the amount required by the commission during the  
11 succeeding biennium for the carrying on of the activities em-  
12 braced in the fish and game division. Such estimate shall be  
13 in the same general form and detail as may be required by law  
14 in estimates submitted by other state departments.

15 "Any unexpended balance at the end of the biennium shall  
16 revert to the fish and game protection fund. If the amount  
17 authorized by the general assembly for any year shall prove to  
18 be insufficient to meet the commission's needs during the year,  
19 the executive council may on proper showing by the commission  
20 authorize such additional amount for the year as may appear to  
21 the council necessary to meet the commission's needs for the  
22 remainder of the year."

1 Sec. 2. Section one hundred seven point twenty-four (107.24),

2 subsection one (1), Code 1966, is hereby amended by inserting in  
3 line one (1) after the word "Expend" the words ", as authorized  
4 by the general assembly under section one hundred seven point  
5 nineteen (107.19) of the Code,".

#### EXPLANATION

This bill provides procedures to place the expenditures made biennially by the State Conservation Commission from the fish and game protection fund under the budget processes even though the fish and game protection fund is a special trust fund. Annual expenditures from this fund exceed three million dollars without legislative considerations or recommendations having been made in the past. This Act will provide for biennial considerations of fish and game protection fund expenditures by the General Assembly in the future.

1 Amend House File 711, Section one (1), by striking  
2 from line sixteen (16) the words "If the amount" and  
3 all of lines seventeen (17) through twenty-two (22).
