A BILL FOR

An Act to make appropriations to members of the Iowa state fair and world food exposition study committee.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the general
2 fund of the state of Iowa to the following named persons the
3 amounts set opposite their respective names in full settlement
4 of all claims they may have against the state of Iowa for ser-
5 vices rendered as members of the Iowa state fair and world
6 food exposition study committee in accordance with house joint
7 resolution twenty-six (26), Acts of the Sixty-first (61st)
8 General Assembly:

11	A. Rae Melrose	300.00
12	Leroy S. Miller.	420.00

1 Sec. 2. The state comptroller is hereby authorized to issue
2 his warrants to the persons named in this Act in the amounts
3 stated, and the treasurer is hereby directed to pay the same
4 from the general fund of the state of Iowa.

1 Sec. 3. The acceptance of said sums by the persons named
2 in this Act shall be in full settlement of all claims against
3 the state of Iowa growing out of the claims described.

1 Sec. 4. This Act being deemed of immediate importance shall
2 take effect and be in full force from and after its publication
3 in The Albia Union-Republican, a newspaper published in Albia,
