A BILL FOR

An Act to make appropriations to legislators serving on legislative study committees.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the general
2 fund of the state of Iowa to the following named persons the

4 ment of all claims which they may have against the state of
5 Iowa for services rendered as a member of a study committee
6 established by the legislative research committee under the
7 provisions of section two point fifty-five (2.55) of the
