A BILL FOR

An Act to appropriate from the general fund of the state of Iowa for capital improvements for institutions under the board of control of state institutions, including construction of new buildings, repairs, improvements, replacements, or alterations, and providing for joint control for the expenditure thereof by the board of control, the governor, and the state comptroller.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the general
2 fund of the state of Iowa to the board of control of state
3 institutions the sum of nine million (9,000,000) dollars to
4 be used in the following manner, to wit:

5 1. Oakdale--security medical facility
6 phase I completion \$ 2,185,000.00
7 2. Medium security institution for men,
8 with determination of the site to be with
9 approval of the budget and financial control
10 committee and the executive council. 3,531,250.00
11 3. To supplement any prior appropriations
12 for capital improvement items for construc-
13 tion of new buildings, repairs, improvements,
14 replacements, or alterations, or for any
15 capital expenditures the board of control
16 may deem necessary for the proper and
17 necessary function of any institution under
18 its jurisdiction 3,283,750.00
19 Total \$ 9,000,000.00

1 Sec. 2. When the board of control has approved a project
2 to be financed with funds appropriated by this Act, a
3 description of said project and estimated cost shall be
4 reported to the governor and state comptroller.

1 Sec. 3. Contracts, plans, and specifications or plan
2 of operation for improvements for which funds are appropriated
3 by this Act shall be submitted by the board of control to
4 the governor and the state comptroller, except that items
5 commonly known as change orders need not be submitted to the
6 governor and the state comptroller unless such change orders
7 actually increase the total cost of that particular project.

1 Sec. 4. Upon completion of the contract documents and the
2 determination of the total cost of any project as set forth
3 in this Act, any unobligated balance remaining may be used to
4 supplement any current or prior appropriation for capital
5 improvement items for construction of new buildings, repairs,
6 improvements, replacements or alterations, or for any other
7 capital expenditures the board of control may deem necessary
8 for proper and necessary function of any institution under
9 its jurisdiction.

1 Sec. 5. The board of control, the governor, and the state
2 comptroller are hereby authorized to obtain federal grants to
3 the state to be used in connection with the funds appropriated
4 by this Act.

1 Sec. 6. Any unencumbered balance remaining as of June 30,
2 1971, of the appropriation of this Act shall revert to the
3 general fund of the state as of June 30, 1971.

1 Sec. 7. If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence,
2 clause, or phrase of this Act is for any reason held to be
3 unconstitutional or invalid, such unconstitutionality or
4 invalidity shall not affect the constitutionality or validity
5 of the remaining portions of this Act. The general assembly
6 hereby declares that it would have passed this Act and each
7 section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase

8 hereof, irrespective of whether any one or more of the sections,
9 subsections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be
10 declared unconstitutional.

2 By inserting in section 1, subsection 2, line 6, after the
word
3 "council" the following:
4 (such funds to be used only for the planning, contracting,
5 constructing, and equipping of any building or buildings used
for
6 detaining, care, and treatment of men and shall not include any
