A BILL FOR

An Act authorizing expenditures by various regulatory boards and agencies from their trust funds for the biennium beginning July 1, 1967 and ending June 30, 1969; to provide for the reversion of unused authorized expenditures in this Act to the fund of original authorization; and to provide for additional authorizations of funds during the biennium if funds authorized by this Act are insufficient.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. The state board of accountancy is hereby author-
2 ized to expend from the fees received under chapter one hundred
3 sixteen (116) of the Code, for each year of the biennium be-
4 ginning July 1, 1967 and ending June 30, 1969 not to exceed
5 seventeen thousand six hundred ninety (17,690) dollars, or so
6 much thereof as may be necessary, to be used in the following
7 manner:

8	For salaries	\$ 3,790.00
9	For board members' travel.	1,200.00
10	For support, maintenance, and miscellaneous	
11	purposes	<u>12,700.00</u>
12	Total	\$ 17,690.00

1 Sec. 2. The board of architectural examiners is hereby
2 authorized to expend from the funds received under section one
3 hundred eighteen point eleven (118.11) of the Code, for each
4 year of the biennium beginning July 1, 1967 and ending June 30,
5 1969 not to exceed ten thousand eighty (10,080) dollars, or so
6 much thereof as may be necessary, to be used in the following
7 manner:

8	For salaries	\$ 6,080.00
9	For board members' per diem and expenses	1,000.00
10	For support, maintenance, and miscellaneous	
11	purposes	<u>3,000.00</u>
12	Total	\$ 10,080.00

1 Sec. 3. The state board of engineering examiners is hereby
 2 authorized to expend from the funds received under section one
 3 hundred fourteen point twelve (114.12) of the Code, for each
 4 year of the biennium beginning July 1, 1967 and ending June 30,
 5 1969 not to exceed thirty thousand two hundred five (30,205) dol-
 6 lars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, to be used in the
 7 following manner:

1 Sec. 4. The state board of examiners in the basic sciences is
 2 hereby authorized to expend from the fees received under section
 3 one hundred forty-six point twelve (146.12) of the Code, for each
 4 year of the biennium beginning July 1, 1967 and ending June 30,
 5 1969 not to exceed ten thousand six hundred (10,600) dollars, or
 6 so much thereof as may be necessary, to be used in the following
 7 manner:

8	For board members' per diem and expenses	\$ 9,000.00
9	For support, maintenance, and miscellaneous	
10	purposes	<u>1,600.00</u>
11	Total	\$ 10,600.00

1 Sec. 5. The state board of veterinary medical examiners is
 2 hereby authorized to expend from fees received under section one
 3 hundred sixty-nine point forty-nine (169.49) of the Code, for
 4 each year of the biennium beginning July 1, 1967 and ending
 5 June 30, 1969 not to exceed three thousand (3,000) dollars, or
 6 so much thereof as may be necessary, to be used in the following

7 manner:

8	Salaries, support, maintenance, and	
9	miscellaneous purposes	\$ <u>3,000.00</u>
10	Total	\$ 3,000.00

1 Sec. 6. The Iowa board of funeral directors and embalmer
 2 examiners is hereby authorized to expend from fees received
 3 under section one hundred forty-seven point one hundred one
 4 (147.101) of the Code, for each year of the biennium beginning
 5 July 1, 1967 and ending June 30, 1969 not to exceed six thousand
 6 five hundred (6,500) dollars, or so much thereof as may be neces-
 7 sary, to be used in the following manner:

8	Per diem, support, maintenance, and	
9	miscellaneous purposes	\$ <u>6,500.00</u>
10	Total	\$ 6,500.00

1 Sec. 7. The state board of dental examiners is hereby
 2 authorized to expend from fees received under section one hun-
 3 dred forty-seven point one hundred fifteen (147.115) of the Code,
 4 for each year of the biennium beginning July 1, 1967 and ending
 5 June 30, 1969 not to exceed six thousand (6,000) dollars, or so
 6 much thereof as may be necessary, to be used in the following
 7 manner:

9	For support, maintenance, and miscellaneous	
10	purposes	<u>500.00</u>
11	Total	\$ 6,000.00

1 Sec. 8. The state board of certification is hereby authorized
 2 to expend from fees received under section one hundred thirty-
 3 six A point fourteen (136A.14) of the Code, for each year of
 4 the biennium beginning July 1, 1967 and ending June 30, 1969
 5 not to exceed three thousand (3,000) dollars, or so much thereof
 6 as may be necessary, to be used in the following manner:

7	For salaries, support, maintenance, and	
8	miscellaneous purposes	\$ <u>3,000.00</u>
9	Total	\$ 3,000.00

1 Sec. 9. The state board of optometry examiners is hereby
 2 authorized to expend from fees received under section one hun-
 3 dred forty-seven point one hundred seventeen (147.117) of the
 4 Code, for each year of the biennium beginning July 1, 1967 and
 5 ending June 30, 1969 not to exceed five thousand (5,000) dollars,
 6 or so much thereof as may be necessary, to be used in the follow-
 7 ing manner:

8	For salaries, support, maintenance, and	
9	miscellaneous purposes	\$ <u>5,000.00</u>
10	Total	\$ 5,000.00

1 Sec. 10. The state board of medical examiners is hereby author-
 2 ized to expend from fees received under section one hundred forty-
 3 seven point one hundred three (147.103) of the Code, for each year
 4 of the biennium beginning July 1, 1967 and ending June 30, 1969
 5 not to exceed thirty-three thousand (33,000) dollars, or so much
 6 thereof as may be necessary, to be used in the following manner:

7	For salaries	\$ 15,000.00
8	For travel	3,000.00
9	For per diem	11,000.00
10	For miscelleneous purposes	<u>4,000.00</u>
11	Total	\$ 33,000.00

1 Sec. 11. The state board of nurse examiners is hereby author-
 2 ized to expend from fees received under section one hundred forty-
 3 seven point one hundred seven (147.107) of the Code, for each
 4 year of the biennium beginning July 1, 1967 and ending June 30,
 5 1969 not to exceed ninety-nine thousand (99,000) dollars, or so
 6 much thereof as may be necessary, to be used in the following
 7 manner:

8	For salaries	\$ 60,000.00
9	For board members' per diem	4,000.00
10	For travel	5,500.00
11	For miscellaneous purposes	<u>29,500.00</u>
12	Total	\$ 99,000.00

1 Sec. 12. The state board of physical therapy examiners is

2 hereby authorized to expend from fees received under section one
 3 hundred forty-seven point one hundred fifteen (147.115) of the
 4 Code, for each year of the biennium beginning July 1, 1967 and
 5 ending June 30, 1969 not to exceed one thousand (1,000) dollars,
 6 or so much thereof as may be necessary, to be used in the fol-
 7 lowing manner:

8	For salaries, support, maintenance, and	
9	miscellaneous purposes	\$ <u>1,000.00</u>
10	Total	\$ 1,000.00

1 Sec. 13. Any balance unused during the first year of the
 2 biennium from which authorization for expenditures are provided
 3 for in this Act shall be carried over and augment the amount
 4 authorized for the second year of the biennium. At the end of
 5 the biennium, any balance remaining shall revert to the fund
 6 from which authorization for expenditures are provided for in
 7 this Act.

1 Sec. 14. No expenditures, except as authorized by this Act,
 2 may be made during the biennium from the funds herein included.
 3 If the authorizations to expend are insufficient to carry out
 4 the needs of the board, agency, or department included in this
 5 Act, the executive council may approve an additional authoriza-
 6 tion to expend from the fund of original authorization, after
 7 first securing the written recommendations on said authorization
 8 from the state comptroller.

1 Sec. 15. Chapter eight (8), Code 1966, shall apply to this
 2 Act.

1 Sec. 16. If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence,
 2 clause or phrase of this Act is for any reason held to be uncon-
 3 stitutional or invalid, such unconstitutionality or invalidity
 4 shall not affect the constitutionality or validity of the remain-
 5 ing portions of this Act. The general assembly hereby declares
 6 that it would have passed this Act and each section, subsection,
 7 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase hereof, irrespective of
 8 whether any one or more of the sections, subsections, paragraphs,

9 sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitutional.

1 Sec. 17. Where any provisions of the law of this state are
2 in conflict with this Act, the provisions of this Act shall
3 govern for the biennium.
