Senate 6-30; 107-0.* **A BILL FOR**

An Act authorizing expenditures by the Iowa aeronautics commission, the Iowa dairy industry commission, the state permit board, the department of public safety, and the statistician of judiciary department, from their trust funds for the biennium beginning July 1, 1967 and ending June 30, 1969; to provide for reversions of unused authorized expenditures in this Act to the fund of original authorization; and to provide for additional authorizations of funds during the biennium if funds authorized by this Act are insufficient.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. The Iowa aeronautics commission is hereby author-
2 ized to expend from the moneys received by the commission under
3 chapter three hundred twenty-eight (328) of the Code, known as
4 the state aviation fund, for each year of the biennium beginning
5 July 1, 1967 and ending June 30, 1969 not to exceed two hundred
6 seventy-four thousand forty-eight (274,048) dollars, or so much
7 thereof as may be necessary, to be used in the following manner:

8	For salaries	\$ 91,100.00
9	For board members' per diem	2,620.00
10	For support, maintenance, and miscellaneous	
11	purposes	55,328.00
12	For airport projects and improvements.	<u>125,000.00</u>
13	Total	\$274,048.00

1 Sec. 2. The Iowa dairy industry commission is hereby author-
2 ized to expend from the moneys received by the commission under
3 chapter one hundred seventy-nine (179) of the Code, known as the
4 dairy industry fund, for each year of the biennium beginning

5 July 1, 1967 and ending June 30, 1969 not to exceed three hundred
6 eighty thousand (380,000) dollars, or so much thereof as may be
7 necessary, to be used in the following manner:

8	For salaries	\$ 34,000.00
9	For travel	5,000.00
10	For payments to American dairy association . . .	250,000.00
11	For support, maintenance, and miscellaneous	
12	purposes	<u>91,000.00</u>
13	Total	\$380,000.00

1 Sec. 3. The state permit board is hereby authorized to expend
2 from the moneys received by the board under section one hundred
3 twenty-four point five (124.5) of the Code, known as the state
4 permit board fund, for each year of the biennium beginning July
5 1, 1967 and ending June 30, 1969 not to exceed twelve thousand
6 (12,000) dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, to be
7 used in the following manner:

8	For salaries	\$ 9,500.00
9	For support, maintenance, and miscellaneous	
10	purposes	<u>2,500.00</u>
11	Total	\$ 12,000.00

1 Sec. 4. The commissioner of public safety is hereby authorized
2 to expend from the moneys received by the department of public
3 safety under section three hundred twenty-two point twelve
4 (322.12) of the Code, known as the motor vehicle dealers license
5 fee fund, for each year of the biennium beginning July 1, 1967
6 and ending June 30, 1969 not to exceed seventy-five thousand
7 (75,000) dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, to
8 be used in the following manner:

9	For salaries	\$ 53,400.00
10	For travel	13,000.00
11	For support, maintenance, and miscellaneous	
12	purposes	<u>8,600.00</u>
13	Total	\$ 75,000.00

1 Sec. 5. The statistician of the judiciary department is hereby

2 authorized to expend from fees received under section six hundred
 3 six point fifteen (606.15) of the Code, for each year of the
 4 biennium beginning July 1, 1967 and ending June 30, 1969 not to
 5 exceed twenty-five thousand (25,000) dollars, or so much thereof
 6 as may be necessary, to be used in the following manner:

7	For salaries	\$ 22,000.00
8	For support, maintenance, and miscellaneous	
9	purposes	<u>3,000.00</u>
10	Total	\$ 25,000.00

1 Sec. 6. Any balance unused during the first year of the
 2 biennium from which authorizations for expenditures are pro-
 3 vided for in this Act shall be carried over and augment the
 4 amount authorized for the second year of the biennium. At the
 5 end of the biennium, any balance remaining shall revert to the
 6 fund from which authorizations for expenditures are provided
 7 for in this Act.

1 Sec. 7. No expenditure, except as authorized by this Act,
 2 may be made during the biennium from the funds herein included.
 3 If the authorizations to expend are insufficient to carry out
 4 the needs of the board, agency, or department included in this
 5 Act, the executive council may approve an additional authorization
 6 to expend from the fund of original authorization, after first
 7 securing the written recommendations on said authorization from
 8 the state comptroller.

1 Sec. 8. Chapter eight (8), Code 1966, shall apply to this
 2 Act.

1 Sec. 9. If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence,
 2 clause or phrase of this Act is for any reason held to be uncon-
 3 stitutional or invalid, such unconstitutionality or invalidity
 4 shall not affect the constitutionality or validity of the re-
 5 maining portions of this Act. The general assembly hereby de-
 6 clares that it would have passed this Act and each section,
 7 subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase hereof,
 8 irrespective of whether any one or more of the sections, sub-

9 sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared
10 unconstitutional.

1 Sec. 10. Where any provisions of the law of this state are
2 in conflict with this Act, the provisions of this Act shall govern
3 for the biennium.

1 Amend House File 760 as follows:
2 By striking from lines 5 and 6 of section 1 the following:
3 "two hundred seventy-four thousand forty-eight (274,048)" and
4 by inserting in lieu thereof the following: "four hundred
5 sixteen thousand (416,000)".
6 By striking from line 8 of section 1 the figures "91,100.00"
7 and by inserting in lieu thereof the figures "101,000.00".
8 By striking from line 9 of section 1 the figures "2,620.00"
9 and by inserting in lieu thereof the figures "5,000.00".
10 By striking from line 11 of section 1 the figures "55,328.00"
11 and by inserting in lieu thereof the figures "110,000.00".
12 By striking from line 12 of section 1 the figures "125,000.00"
13 and by inserting in lieu thereof the figures "200,000.00".
14 By striking from line 13 of section 1 the figures "274,048.00"
15 and by inserting in lieu thereof the figures "416,000.00".
