A BILL FOR

An Act to authorize expenditures by various regulatory divisions in the department of agriculture from trust funds for the biennium beginning July 1, 1967 and ending June 30, 1969; to provide for reversion of unused authorized expenditures in this Act to the fund of original authorization; and to provide for additional authorization of funds during the biennium if funds authorized in this Act are insufficient.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. The department of agriculture is hereby author-
2 ized to expend from the fees received under chapter one hundred
3 ninety-eight (198) of the Code, known as the commercial feed
4 fund, for each year of the biennium beginning July 1, 1967 and
5 ending June 30, 1969 not to exceed two hundred fifty-eight
6 thousand (258,000) dollars, or so much thereof as may be nec-
7 essary, to be used in the following manner:

8	For salaries	\$215,000.00
9	For travel	19,000.00
10	For equipment.	6,000.00
11	For support, maintenance, and miscellaneous	
12	purposes	<u>18,000.00</u>
13	Total	\$258,000.00

1 Sec. 2. The department of agriculture is hereby authorized
2 to expend from the fees received under chapter one hundred seventy
3 (170) of the Code, known as the restaurant inspection fund, for
4 each year of the biennium beginning July 1, 1967 and ending June
5 30, 1969 not to exceed one hundred thousand (100,000) dollars, or
6 so much thereof as may be necessary, to be used in the following

7 manner:

8	For salaries	\$ 80,000.00
9	For travel	15,000.00
10	For equipment.	500.00
11	For support, maintenance, and miscellaneous	
12	purposes	<u>4,500.00</u>
13	Total	\$100,000.00

1 Sec. 3. The department of agriculture is hereby authorized
 2 to expend from the fees received under chapter two hundred six
 3 (206) of the Code, known as the pesticide fund, for each year of
 4 the biennium beginning July 1, 1967 and ending June 30, 1969 not
 5 to exceed fifty thousand six hundred (50,600) dollars, or so much
 6 thereof as may be necessary, to be used in the following manner:

7	For salaries	\$ 36,630.00
8	For travel	4,170.00
9	For equipment.	500.00
10	For support, maintenance, and miscellaneous	
11	purposes	<u>9,300.00</u>
12	Total	\$ 50,600.00

1 Sec. 4. The department of agriculture is hereby authorized to
 2 expend from the fees received under chapter two hundred (200) of
 3 the Code, known as the fertilizer fund, for each year of the bien-
 4 nium beginning July 1, 1967 and ending June 30, 1969 not to exceed
 5 sixty-seven thousand three hundred (67,300) dollars, or so much
 6 thereof as may be necessary, to be used in the following manner:

7	For salaries	\$ 56,900.00
8	For travel	3,100.00
9	For equipment.	500.00
10	For support, maintenance, and miscellaneous	
11	purposes	<u>6,800.00</u>
12	Total	\$ 67,300.00

1 Sec. 5. The department of agriculture is hereby authorized to
 2 expend from the fees received under chapter one hundred ninety-
 3 two A (192A) of the Code, known as the dairy trade practices fund,

4 for each year of the biennium beginning July 1, 1967 and ending
5 June 30, 1969 not to exceed fifty-five thousand (55,000) dollars,
6 or so much thereof as may be necessary, to be used in the follow-
7 ing manner:

8	For salaries	\$ 39,100.00
9	For travel	6,000.00
10	For equipment.	600.00
11	For support, maintenance, and miscellaneous	
12	purposes	<u>9,300.00</u>
13	Total	\$ 55,000.00

1 Sec. 6. Any balance unused during the first year of the bien-
2 nium for which authorizations for expenditures are provided for
3 in this Act shall be carried over and augment the amount author-
4 ized for the second year of the biennium. At the end of the
5 biennium, any balance remaining shall revert to the fund from
6 which authorizations for expenditures are provided for in this
7 Act.

1 Sec. 7. No expenditure, except as authorized by this Act, may
2 be made during the biennium from the fund herein included. If
3 the authorizations to expend are insufficient to carry out the
4 needs of the department of agriculture from the funds herein
5 included, the executive council may approve an additional authori-
6 zation to expend from the fund of original authorization, after
7 first securing the written recommendations on said authorization
8 from the state comptroller.

1 Sec. 8. Chapter eight (8), Code 1966, shall apply to this
2 Act.

1 Sec. 9. If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence,
2 clause or phrase of this Act is for any reason held to be uncon-
3 stitutional or invalid, such unconstitutionality or invalidity
4 shall not affect the constitutionality or validity of the re-
5 maining portions of this Act. The general assembly hereby de-
6 clares that it would have passed this Act and each section, sub-
7 section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase hereof, irrespective

8 of whether any one or more of the sections, subsections, para-
9 graphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitutional.

1 Sec. 10. Where any provisions of the law of this state are in
2 conflict with this Act, the provisions of this Act shall govern
3 for the biennium.
