A BILL FOR

An Act to make appropriations to legislators serving on legislative study committees.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the general
2 fund of the state of Iowa to the following named persons the
3 amounts set opposite their respective names in full settlement
4 of all claims which they may have against the state of Iowa
5 for services rendered as a member of a study committee estab-
6 lished by the legislative research committee under the pro-
7 visions of section two point fifty-five (2.55) of the Code:

1 Sec. 2. The state comptroller is hereby authorized to
2 issue his warrants to the persons named in this Act in the
3 amounts stated, and the treasurer is hereby directed to pay
4 the same from the general fund of the state of Iowa.

1 Sec. 3. The acceptance of said sums by the persons named
2 in this Act shall be in full settlement of all claims against
3 the state of Iowa growing out of the claims described.

1 Amend House File 772 by adding the following section
2 thereto:

3 This Act, being deemed of immediate importance, shall
4 be in full force and effect from and after its passage and
5 publication in The Perry Daily Chief, a newspaper published
6 at Perry, Iowa and in the Oelwein Daily Register, a news-
7 paper published at Oelwein, Iowa.
