# A BILL FOR

*Passed Senate per Conference Committee  
Report 7-1-67; 53-0*

An Act to appropriate from the general fund of the state of Iowa for the biennium beginning July 1, 1967 and ending June 30, 1969 funds for various legislative departmental expenses and to create the general contingent fund of the state specifying the purposes for which the appropriation may be used.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

## LEGISLATIVE RESEARCH BUREAU

1 Section 1. For the legislative research bureau there is  
2 hereby appropriated from the general fund of the state for each  
3 year of the biennium beginning July 1, 1967 and ending June 30,  
4 1969 the sum of one hundred twenty-five thousand (125,000) dol-  
5 lars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, to be used in the  
6 following manner:

7 For salaries, support, maintenance, and  
8 miscellaneous purposes . . . . . \$ 125,000.00  
9 Grand total of all appropriations for all

## INTERSTATE COOPERATION, COMMISSION ON

1 Sec. 2. For the commission on interstate cooperation there  
2 is hereby appropriated from the general fund of the state for  
3 each year of the biennium beginning July 1, 1967 and ending June  
4 30, 1969 the sum of five thousand five hundred (5,500) dollars,  
5 or so much thereof as may be necessary, to be used in the fol-  
6 lowing manner:

7 For expenses of commission members in

8 carrying out their obligations under  
 9 chapter twenty-eight B (28B) of the Code . . . . \$ 5,500.00  
 10 Grand total of all appropriations for all  
 11 purposes for each year of the biennium for  
 12 the commission on interstate cooperation . . . . \$ 5,500.00

GENERAL CONTINGENT FUND

1 Sec. 3. The general contingent fund of the state for the  
 2 biennium beginning July 1, 1967 and ending June 30, 1969 is  
 3 hereby created and said fund shall consist of the sum of one  
 4 million eight hundred thousand (1,800,000) dollars hereby ap-  
 5 propriated thereto from the general fund of the state. Said  
 6 contingent fund shall be administered by the budget and finan-  
 7 cial control committee and allocation therefrom may be made  
 8 only for contingencies arising during the biennium which are  
 9 legally payable from the funds of the state but not including  
 10 contingencies as defined in section nineteen point seven (19.7)  
 11 of the Code. Allocations may be made for compensation and  
 12 expense of members of the budget and financial control commit-  
 13 tee, authorized by section two point forty-five (2.45) of the  
 14 Code, and for the payment of obligations incurred under the  
 15 provisions of section two point forty-four (2.44), subsection  
 16 six (6), of the Code, and section two point forty-six (2.46)  
 17 of the Code. The budget and financial control committee shall  
 18 not allocate any funds for any purpose or project which was  
 19 presented to the general assembly by way of a bill and which  
 20 failed to become enacted into law. A report of the disposi-  
 21 tions made of the fund during the first eighteen (18) months  
 22 of the biennium shall be made by the budget and financial con-  
 23 trol committee to the state comptroller prior to the convening  
 24 of the Sixty-third (63rd) General Assembly and by him included  
 25 in the printed budget. Any balance in said contingent fund as  
 26 of June 30, 1969, shall revert to the general fund of the  
 27 state.

1 Amend House File 786 as follows:  
2 By striking all after the word "expenses" in line 3 of the

4 and by inserting in lieu thereof the words, "and for membership  
5 dues  
6 for the national conference of state legislative leaders."  
7 By striking from line 8 of section 1 the figure "125,000.00"  
8 and  
9 by inserting in lieu thereof the figure "190,000.00". By strik-  
10 ing from  
11 line 11 of section 1, the figure "125,000.00" and by inserting  
12 in lieu  
13 thereof the figure "190,000.00".  
14 By striking the following words just before section 3: "GENERAL  
15 CONTINGENT FUND" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words  
16 "BUDGET  
17 AND FINANCIAL CONTROL COMMITTEE". Further amend by  
18 striking all of section 3 and by inserting in lieu thereof the  
19 following:  
20 "Sec. 3. There is appropriated from the general fund of the  
21 state  
22 of Iowa to the budget and financial control committee the sum  
23 of two  
24 hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000.00) for the biennium begin-  
25 ning  
26 July 1, 1967, and ending June 30, 1969, or so much thereof as  
27 may  
28 be necessary to carry out the provisions of section two point  
29 forty-  
30 four (2.44), Code 1966, and for the compensation and expense of  
31 members of the budget and financial control committee authorized  
32 by section two point forty-five (2.45), Code 1966, and the pro-  
33 visions  
34 of sections two point forty-six (2.46), two point forty-seven  
35 (2.47),  
36 and two point forty-eight (2.48), Code 1966. Any balance in  
37 said  
38 contingent fund as of June 30, 1969, shall revert to the general  
fund  
of the state as of June 30, 1969."  
By adding thereto the following new section:  
"NATIONAL CONFERENCE OF STATE LEGISLATIVE LEADERS  
"There is hereby appropriated to the national conference of  
state legislative leaders from the general fund of the state for  
each  
year of the biennium beginning July 1, 1967 and ending June 30,  
1969  
the sum of one thousand (\$1,000) dollars, or so much thereof as  
may  
be necessary, to be used in the following manner:  
"For annual dues for membership to  
the national conference of state  
legislative leaders.....\$ 1,000.00  
"Grand total of all appropriations  
for each year for annual dues to the  
national conference of state legisla-  
tive leaders.....\$ 1,000.00"

As Adopted by the Senate - House refused to concur, Senate insisted 7-1-67.

1 Amend House File 786 as follows:  
 2 1. Amend the title by striking all after the  
 3 word "expenses" in line three (3) and by insert-  
 4 ing in lieu thereof a period (.).  
 5 2. By striking the following which appears just  
 6 before section three (3) "GENERAL CONTINGENT FUND"  
 7 and inserting in lieu thereof "BUDGET AND  
 8 FINANCIAL CONTROL COMMITTEE", and by striking all  
 9 of section three (3) and inserting in lieu  
 10 thereof the following:  
 11 Sec. 3. There is appropriated from the general  
 12 fund of the state of Iowa to the budget and  
 13 financial control committee the sum of two hundred  
 14 thousand dollars (\$200,000.00) for the biennium  
 15 beginning July 1, 1967, and ending June 30, 1969,  
 16 or so much thereof as may be necessary, to carry out  
 17 the provisions of section two point forty-four (2.44),  
 18 Code 1966, and for the compensation and expense of  
 19 members of the budget and financial control committee  
 20 authorized by section two point forty-five (2.45),  
 21 Code 1966, and the provisions of section two point  
 22 forty-six (2.46), two point forty-seven (2.47), and  
 23 of section two point forty-eight (2.48), Code 1966. Any balance  
 24 in the contingent fund as of June 30, 1969, shall  
 25 revert to the general fund of the state as of  
 26 June 30, 1969.

TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE AND THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

We, the undersigned members of the Conference Committee appointed to consider the differences between the Senate and the House on House File 786, a bill for an Act to appropriate from the general fund of the state of Iowa for the biennium beginning July 1, 1967 and ending June 30, 1969 funds for various legislative departmental expenses and to create the general contingent fund of the state specifying the purposes for which the appropriation may be used, begs leave to report and to make the following recommendations:

Amend the Senate Amendment to House File 786 as follows:

1. Section 3, lines two (2) and three (3), by striking the words and figures "two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000.00)" and inserting in lieu thereof the words and figures "three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000.00)".

2. By adding thereto the following new sections:

"The general contingent fund of the state for the biennium beginning July 1, 1967 and ending June 30, 1969 is hereby created and said fund shall consist of the sum of one million seven hundred thousand (1,700,000) dollars hereby appropriated thereto from the general fund of the state. The contingent fund shall be administered by the executive council and allocations therefrom may be made only for contingencies arising during the biennium which are legally payable from the funds of the state. The executive council shall not allocate any funds for any purpose or project which was presented to the general assembly by way of a bill and which failed to become enacted into law.

"Before any of the funds appropriated by this Act shall be allocated, a written recommendation shall be obtained from the state comptroller and the executive council and they shall determine that the proposed allocation shall be for the best interest of the state. Any allocation in excess of thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000.00) shall first be approved by the budget and financial control committee.

"Any balance in the contingent fund as of June 30, 1969 shall revert to the general fund of the state as of June 30, 1969.

3. Further amend by adding the following new sections:

"This Act shall operate retroactively and retrospectively, with full force and effect, to and from July 1, 1967.

"This Act, being deemed of immediate importance, shall take effect after its passage, approval and publication in The Emmetsburg Democrat, a newspaper published at Emmetsburg, Iowa, and in The Sheffield Press, a newspaper published in Sheffield, Iowa."

REPORT OF THE JOINT COMMITTEE OF THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES  
ON THE SENATE AMENDMENT TO HOUSE FILE 786

The undersigned members of the Conference Committee appointed to consider the differences between the Senate and the House on House File 786, a bill for an Act to appropriate from the general fund of the state of Iowa for the biennium beginning July 1, 1969, the 1969 funds for various legislative departmental expenses and to create a general contingent fund of the state specifying the purposes for which the appropriation may be used, begs leave to report and to make the following recommendations:

1. Amend the Senate Amendment to House File 786 as follows:

1. Section 3, lines two (2) and three (3), by striking the words and figures "two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000.00)" and inserting in lieu thereof the words and figures "three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000.00)".

2. By adding thereto the following new sections:

"The general contingent fund of the state for the biennium beginning July 1, 1969, and ending June 30, 1969 is hereby created; said fund shall consist of the sum of one million seven hundred thousand (\$1,700,000) dollars hereby appropriated thereto from the general fund of the state. The contingent fund shall be administered by the executive council and disbursements therefrom may be made only for contingencies arising during the biennium which are legally due from the funds of the state. The executive council shall not disburse any funds for any purpose or project which was presented to the general assembly by way of a bill and which failed to become enacted into law.

"Before any of the funds appropriated by this Act shall be allocated, a written recommendation shall be obtained from the state comptroller and the executive council and they shall determine that the proposed allocation shall be for the best interest of the state. Any allocation in excess of thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000.00) shall first be approved by the budget and financial control committee.

"Any balance in the contingent fund as of June 30, 1969 shall revert to the general fund of the state as of June 30, 1969.

3. Further amend by adding the following new sections:

"This Act shall operate retroactively and retrospectively, with full force and effect, to and from July 1, 1967.

"This Act, being deemed of immediate importance, shall take effect after its passage, approval and publication in The Emmetsburg Democrat, a newspaper published at Emmetsburg, Iowa, and in The Sheffield Press, a newspaper published in Sheffield, Iowa."
