# A BILL FOR

An Act to appropriate from the general fund of the state of Iowa to the department of public instruction for specified school aid.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the general  
2 fund of the state of Iowa to the department of public instruc-  
3 tion for each year of the biennium beginning July 1, 1967 and  
4 ending June 30, 1969 the sum of three million five hundred  
5 fifty thousand (3,550,000) dollars, or so much thereof as may  
6 be necessary, to be used in the following manner:

7	Aid to handicapped children [special	
8	education as provided in chapter two	
9	hundred eighty-one (281) of the Code] . . . . .	\$ 3,500,000.00
10	Emergency aid for schools providing	
11	none of which shall be distributed to	
12	any school which the department esti-	
13	mates could maintain reasonable educa-	
14	tional standards without levying a	
15	tax in excess of one hundred (100)	
16	mills . . . . .	<u>50,000.00</u>
17	Total . . . . .	\$ 3,550,000.00

1 Sec. 2. Any unencumbered balance shall revert in the manner  
2 provided by chapter eight (8), Code 1966.
