A BILL FOR

An Act relating to fish bait.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. Section one hundred nine point eighty (109.80),
- 2 Code 1966, is hereby amended by striking the period after the
- 3 word "fin" in line sixteen (16) and adding the following:
- 4 ", except green sunfish and orange-spotted sunfish."

EXPLANATION

Nearly all ponds and artificial lakes are vastly overpopulated with these green sunfish. Due to their small size, they have little or no angling value. They compete directly with the more desirable species for food and space and are considered a nuisance.

- 1 Amend House File 98 as follows:
- 2 1. By striking everything after the enacting clause and
- 3 inserting in lieu thereof the following:
- 4 "Section 1. Section one hundred nine point eighty
- 5 (109.80), Code 1966, is hereby amended by adding, beginning
- 6 in line sixteen (16), the following new sentence; 'Green
- 7 sunfish and orange-spotted sunfish may also be taken as bait.'"
