A BILL FOR

An Act relating to the offering of courses in driver education.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Section three hundred twenty-one point one
2 hundred seventy-seven (321.177), Code 1966, is hereby amended
3 by inserting in line twenty-two (22) of subsection seven (7)
4 after the word "education." the following:

5 "An approved course offered during the summer months, on
6 Saturdays, or after regular school hours during the regular
7 term shall satisfy the requirements of this section to the
8 same extent as an approved course offered during the regular
9 school hours of the school term."

1 Amend the Kibbie and Benda amendment filed February 2, 1967
2 as follows:
3 1. By striking the word "The" in line five (5) and
4 inserting in lieu thereof the word "the".
