A BILL FOR

An Act relating to relief to Viet Nam soldiers, sailors and marines.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Section two hundred fifty point one (250.1),
2 Code 1966, is amended by inserting in line twelve (12)
3 after the word "inclusive," the words "and including the
4 Viet Nam Conflict at any time between August 5, 1964 and
5 ending on the date the armed forces of the United States
6 are directed by formal order of the government of the
7 United States to cease hostilities, both dates inclusive,".

1 Sec. 2. Section two hundred fifty point three (250.3),
2 Code 1966, is amended by inserting in line eight (8) after
3 the word "inclusive" the words ", and including the Viet
4 Nam Conflict at any time between August 5, 1964 and ending
5 on the date the armed forces of the United States are
6 directed by formal order of the government of the United
7 States to cease hostilities, both dates inclusive".

1 Sec. 3. Section two hundred fifty point thirteen (250.13),
2 Code 1966, is amended by inserting in line eleven (11) after
3 the word "inclusive," the words "and including the Viet Nam
4 Conflict at any time between August 5, 1964 and ending on the
5 date the armed forces of the United States are directed by
6 formal order of the government of the United States to cease

7 hostilities, both dates inclusive,".

1 Sec. 4. Section two hundred fifty point sixteen (250.16),
2 Code 1966, is amended by inserting in line thirteen (13) after
3 the word "inclusive," the words "and including the Viet Nam
4 Conflict at any time between August 5, 1964 and ending on the
5 date the armed forces of the United States are directed by
6 formal order of the government of the United States to cease
7 hostilities, both dates inclusive,".

1 Amend Senate File 11 as follows:

2 By striking the words "August 5, 1964" in line 4 of section 1,
3 line 4 of section 2, line 4 of section 3, and line 4 of section 4
4 and inserting in lieu of the words "July 1, 1960".
