A BILL FOR

An Act to allow the Iowa conservation commission to waive the requirement of a fishing license for certain severely handicapped adults.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Section one hundred ten point seventeen (110.17),

2 Code 1966, is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:

3 "No handicapped adult who requires adult supervision, at all

4 times, shall be required to have a fishing license to fish in

5 the rivers and streams in the state of Iowa, provided he is

6 under the supervision of an adult who is duly licensed for this

7 sport by the state conservation commission."

1 Sec. 2. The state conservation commission is hereby author-

2 ized to prepare an application to be used by the person request-

3 ing handicapped adult status, which would require that his

4 attending physician sign the form declaring the person a handi-

5 capped adult and eligible for exempt status.

1 Amend Senate File 124 by adding a new section as follows:
2 Section 1. No resident sixty-five (65) years and
3 older shall be required to have a license to fish in
4 the rivers and streams or any other body of water in
5 the State of Iowa. No special identification shall
6 be necessary for this purpose.

license
6 to residents of Iowa sixteen (16) years or more of age who the
commission
7 finds are mentally or physically severely handicapped. Such
special
8 license shall be valid only when the holder is fishing under
supervision.
9 The commission is hereby authorized to prepare an application to
be used
10 by the person requesting handicapped status, which would require
that his
11 attending physician sign the form declaring the person handicapped
and
12 eligible for exempt status."
