A BILL FOR

An Act to change the method of marking waterfowl.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Section one hundred ten A point five (110A.5),
2 Code 1966, is hereby amended by striking from lines twenty-
3 two (22) and twenty-three (23) the words "be punched through
4 the outer web of the bird's" and inserting in lieu thereof
5 the words "have the hind toe removed from the".

1 Amend Senate File 132 by striking all after the enacting
2 clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
3 "Section 1. Section one hundred ten A point five
4 (110A.5), Code 1966, is hereby amended by striking all of
5 lines twenty-one (21) through twenty-five (25), inclusive,
6 and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
7 "All waterfowl released for shooting purposes shall be
8 marked in a manner prescribed by the state conservation
9 commission so as to provide for permanent identification."
