A BILL FOR

An Act establishing a minimum inspection fee for small packages of commercial fertilizer.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Section two hundred point eight (200.8), Code
2 1966, is hereby amended as follows:

3 1. By inserting in line fifteen (15) of subsection one
4 (1) of such section after the word "a" the word "minimum".

5 2. By striking from line sixteen (16) of subsection one
6 (1) of such section the word "twenty-five" and inserting in
7 lieu thereof the word "ten (10)".

1 Amend Senate File 147 by striking all after the
2 enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the
3 following:

4 Section 1. Section two hundred point four (200.4),
5 subsection one (1), Code 1966, is hereby amended by
6 adding thereto the following:

7 "This subsection shall not apply to a manufacturer
8 who manufactures 'specialty fertilizer' only, as defined
9 in subsection five (5) of section two hundred point three
10 (200.3) of the Code, in packages of twenty-five pounds or
11 less."

12 Sec. 2. Section two hundred point eight (200.8), sub-
13 section one (1), Code 1966, is hereby amended by striking
14 lines thirteen (13) through eighteen (18) of said sub-
15 section and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

16 "On individual packages of specialty fertilizer con-
17 taining twenty-five pounds or less, there shall be paid
18 in lieu of the annual license fee and the semiannual
19 inspection fee as set forth in this chapter, an annual
20 registration and inspection fee of twenty-five dollars
21 for each brand and grade sold or distributed in the state.
22 In the event that any person sells specialty fertilizer in
23 packages of twenty-five pounds or less and also in packages
24 of more than twenty-five pounds, this annual registration
25 and inspection fee shall apply only to that portion sold
26 in packages of twenty-five pounds or less, and that portion
27 sold in packages of more than twenty-five pounds shall be
28 subject to the same inspection fee as fixed by the
29 secretary of agriculture as provided in this chapter."

30 Section two hundred point eight (200.8), Code
31 1966, is further amended by adding to paragraph a of
32 subsection two (2) the following:

33 "However, in lieu of the semiannual statement by
34 grade for each county, as hereinabove provided for,
35 the registrant, on individual packages of commercial
36 fertilizer containing twenty-five pounds or less,
37 shall file not later than the last day of July of
38 each year, on forms furnished by the secretary, an
39 annual statement setting forth the number of net tons
40 of commercial fertilizer distributed in this state
41 by grade during the preceding twelve-month period, but
42 no inspection fee shall be due thereon."

26 more than twenty-five pounds shall be subject to the same
27 inspection fee as fixed by the secretary of agriculture as
28 provided in this chapter."

29 Section two hundred point eight (200.8), Code 1966,
30 is further amended by adding to paragraph a of subsection
1 two (2) the following:

32 "In lieu of the above provisions, on individual packages
33 of commercial fertilizer containing twenty-five pounds or
34 less, the registrant shall file not later than the last day
35 of July of each year, on forms furnished by the secretary,
36 an annual statement setting forth the number of net tons of
37 commercial fertilizer distributed in this state by grade
38 during the preceding twelve-month period, but no inspection
39 fee shall be due thereon."
