A BILL FOR

An Act relating to larceny from parking meters.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. If any person opens, steals, takes and carries
 2 away, or attempts to open, steal, take and carry away monies,
 3 regardless of the value or amount thereof, from a parking
 4 meter erected and maintained by a city or town pursuant to
 5 section three hundred ninety point seven (390.7), he shall
 6 be guilty of larceny from a parking meter and upon the first
 7 conviction thereof he shall be punished by imprisonment in
 8 the penitentiary or county jail for not more than one (1)
 9 year, or by fine of not more than five hundred (500) dollars,
 10 or by both such fine and imprisonment; upon each subsequent
 11 conviction thereof he shall be punished by imprisonment in
 12 the penitentiary for not more than five (5) years, or by fine
 13 of not more than one thousand (1000) dollars, or by both such
 14 fine and imprisonment.

1 Amend S. F. 168 by adding the following.
2 "Sec. 2. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance

3 force and effect from and after its passage and publication shall be in full
 4 in The West Des Moines Express, a newspaper published at West as provided by law.
